Ulla Casalini holds a diploma in piano as a student at the Conservatory of Florence, where she also studied chamber music and composition. Subsequently, she studied piano with Bruno Mezzena and vocal accompanying with Erik Werba and Irwin Gage, with whom she pursued in-depth study of Lieder. Her career progressed with performance opportunities primarily in the field of chamber music and art song.

She has been guest artist with premier performing organizations, such as Giovine Orchestra Genovese, Società Filarmonica in Trento, Festival di musica vocale in Carpi, Teatro Comunale in Bologna, Amici della Musica in Perugia, Ravenna Festival, Unione Musicale in Torino, Teatro Comunale in Florence, Teatro Regio in Parma, Teatro Comunale in Cagliari.

As harpsichordist of the Progetto Mozart – Da Ponte she has performed in the Auditorium Rai in Torino, Teatro Verdi in Pisa, Teatro Comunale in Ferrara, Theatre Montansier in Versailles, Britten Theatre in London. She collaborates regularly with fellow performing artists at the Conservatory of Florence, the Accademia Musicale Chigiana in Siena, Amici della Musica in Florence, Istituto Musicale in Modena.
